AMLS is a sixteen-hour, two-day program that consists of interactive lectures, teaching and evaluation stations. The interactive/case based lectures include the following topics:

- Altered Mental Status and Neurologic Disorders
- Respiratory Dysfunction
- Shock
- Chest Discomfort
- Endocrine, Metabolic and Environmental Disorders
- Abdominal Discomfort
- Infectious Disease and Toxicology Emergencies
- Hazardous Materials and Weapons of Mass Destruction

Teaching stations follow the associated lectures each day.

16 hours of CEUs will be awarded in multiple categories
