

# PHTLS & AMLS

Lake EMS has become a training site for PHTLS and AMLS programs provided by NAEMT. The training programs are approved by Dr. Desmond Fitzpatrick for CEUs. If you are interested in registering for these courses contact the LEMS Administrative Office. All classes begin at 9:00am each day.

PHTLS will provide participants a chance to review a mixture of topics related to trauma care in the pre-hospital setting. This program is both a didactic and hands-on course. Participants should understand that the Provider Course is two full 8 hour days.

**16 hours of CEUs will be awarded in the Trauma category**

AMLS is a sixteen-hour, two-day program that consists of interactive lectures, teaching and evaluation stations. The interactive/case based lectures include the following topics: altered mental status and neurologic disorders, respiratory dysfunction, shock, chest discomfort, endocrine, metabolic and environmental disorders, abdominal discomfort, infectious disease, and toxicology emergencies, hazardous materials and weapons of mass destruction. Teaching stations follow the associated lectures each day.

**16 hours of CEUs will be awarded in multiple categories**

When registering for these courses please remember we are limited to 30 students. This course is open to all providers in the Lake EMS system.
